Rising from these rostra, standing tall in the middle, stands the traditional symbol of Western medicine, the Caduceus, which signifies the Greek deity Hermes and features two snakes winding around a winged staff. The resilient beautiful flowers which intertwine the winged staff represent the modern-day Florence Nightingales, while the supplementing leaves signify pharmacy and other allied healthcare professions.
