In pursuance of UGC DO letter no. F.1-15/2009 (ARC) Pt. III dated 14th December, 2023, it is mandatory for each student and every parent to submit an online undertaking in the beginning of each academic year at [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in).

Following registration, the candidates will receive an Anti-Ragging Undertaking Reference Number generated by the UGC. This is required to be filled by the candidates in the online application form.

Each candidate will forward that e-mail to the Nodal Officer in the University at the time of reporting in the affiliated college.

- Step-6: Reporting at Nodal Centre Lucknow by successful candidates, submission of original documents and tuition fees through a demand draft in favour of Director General Medical Education & Training, U.P., payable at Lucknow.
- Step-7: If you have been allotted GS Medical College or GS Ayurveda Medical College, report at GS University, Pilkhuwa, Hapur with the following documents:

## Details pertaining to GSNET 2025 for admission to BSc Nursing

GS University invites application for its bachelor degree programme B.Sc. Nursing for the academic year 2025-26. The eligibility criteria are as follows:

### Eligibility Criteria

#### Academic eligibility

Candidate must have passed 12<sup>th</sup> class examination in science stream from a recognized Board of Education with at least 45% aggregate marks in the subject of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) and with pass marks in English.

#### Age

The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years and the maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.

### GSNET 2025 Curriculum

Should you meet the eligibility criteria, register with us to appear in GSNET 2025. This entrance test will cover the following subjects in the given proportions:

Nursing aptitude	20%
Physics	20%
Chemistry	20%
